



 - **Document Supply**

(a) an express statement that a fair use of copyright material does not infringe copyright; (b) a non-exhaustive list of the factors to be considered in determining whether the use is a fair use ('the fairness factors'); and (c) a non-exhaustive list of illustrative uses or purposes that may qualify as fair uses ('the illustrative purposes').





Exception Illustrative purposes Fairness Factors – is it fair?



(a) research or study; (b) criticism or review; (c) parody or satire; (d) reporting news; (e) non-consumptive; (f) private and domestic; (g) quotation; (h) education; and (i) public administration

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(a) the purpose and character of the use; (b) the nature of the copyright material used; (c) in a case where part only of the copyright material is used—the amount and substantiality of the part used, considered in relation to the whole of the copyright material; and (d) the effect of the use upon the potential market for, or value of, the copyright material.






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
